City Parks, Trails, Skate Parks, Sport Courts & Dog Park Open

- All parks and trails in Brea are open for households to take a walk, run, or dog walk, as long as physical distancing is maintained.
- Parks are not open for gatherings and park amenities are **closed**.

- Sport Courts (basketball, tennis) are for drop-in use only and no organized sports are allowed. Skate/play at your own risk.
